The Condition of the above obligation is such:

That Whereas, James H. Stoverwood hath prayed and obtained a license to marry Sis. Noley Now, if the said James H. Stoverwood Sis. Noley be an actual resident in the County aforesaid, and there shall not hereafter appear any lawful cause why the said Sis. Noley James Stoverwood and Sis. Noley James Stoverwood should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony as Husband and Wife, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
