

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, W. B. French, of Route 3, Camden, Tennessee, being of sound mind and memory, hereby revoke all former will and codicils and make this my last Will and Testament in the manner following:

I

PAYMENT OF DEBTS

I direct that all my debts, funeral expenses, and all inheritance taxes, including the costs of the administration of my estate be first paid out of my estate.

II

GIFT OF LIFE ESTATE

I give, devise and bequeath unto my wife, Vera Potter French, for her life, or until she is unable to make use or unwilling to make use of said property, a life estate in and to my home and household furnishings located at Route 3, Camden, Tennessee.

III

GIFT OF AUTOMOBILE

I direct that my Executor of this Will sell my automobile, converting it to cash, and immediately upon selling said automobile, I direct that my Executor give one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the proceeds from said automobile to my wife, Vera Potter French.

IV

GIFT OF REMAINDER

I give, devise and bequeath all the remainder of my estate, both real and personal, of whatsoever kind and wheresoever situated, of which I shall die seized and possessed, or of which I shall be entitled to dispose of at the time of my death, to my four children, Willard E. French, now residing in Orlanda, FL,

Mary Jo Norwood, now residing in Dyersburg, Tennessee, Wanda Lou Troutt, now residing at Route 1, Bruceton, Tennessee, Tommy French, now residing in Bruceton, Tennessee, and to the child of my fifth son, my son being William B. French who died a few years ago, leaving surviving him one daughter, whose first name is Carolyn, but whose last name is unknown to me, said child now residing in Texas with her mother, the above five individuals, share and share alike, per stirpes.

APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTOR

I nominate and appoint my son, Tommy French, to be Executor of this my will, without bond, and if notwithstanding this request any bond is required by any law, statute, or rule of court, no sureties be required thereon. I direct that my Executor convert my entire estate to cash, including any real property that I might own at the time of my death, and direct that my Executor be given the power to sell same, using his sole discretion as to the time and method of doing so, subject however, to the above mentioned life estate in and to my wife, Vera Potter French.
