The Condition of the above Obligation is such, that whereas the above bounden *Irwin Casp* hath made application for a Licence for Marriage to be celebrated between him and *Mary Pearce* of the County aforesaid: Now, in case it shall not appear hereafter, that there is any lawful Cause or Impediment to obstruct the said Marriage, then the above Obligation to be void; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
