tors, and each and every one of us and them, both jointly and severally, firmly by
these presents.

The Condition of the above obligation is such:

That Whereas, Mark Leale
hath prayed and obtained a license to marry Mary E. Mitchell
Now, if the said Mary E. Mitchell
be an actual resident in the County aforesaid, and there shall not hereafter appear
any lawful cause why the said Mark Leale and
Mary E. Mitchell should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony
as Husband and Wife, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise
to remain in full force and virtue.
