In the name of God, amen.

I Abner Hatley of the County of Chatham, and State of North Carolina, being in my Sixty ninth year of age and in a low state of health, but sound in mind and memory as usual, Thank, be to God for it, do make, and ordain, this, my last Will, and Testament in manner and for as follows. -

1st Item, That all my just debts be paid -

2^d Item, I give and bequeath unto my son Britton Hatley Five Negroes, namely, Jacob, Ruffin, Lulany, Sabey, and Cliska to him and his heirs forever -

3^d Item, I give and bequeath unto my son Redden Hatley, Five Negroes, namely, Pincey, Simson, Elizabeth, and Lewis, (son of Mary); also my blacksmiths tools, with all the apperances, there unto belonging, to him and his heirs forever -

4th Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lulpha Hatley, Five Negroes, namely, Judia, Andrew, Emily, Haywood, and Martha, to her and her heirs forever -

5th Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Cynthia Hatley, Five negroes, namely, Amy, Pile, Moriah, Ruben, and Washington, also one Sorred Mare and Colt, Two Cows and Calves, Two Sows and Pigs, to her and her heirs forever -

6th Item, I give and bequeath unto my son John Hatley Six Negroes, namely, Reason, Alley, Irony, Henry, Horras and Kellyard, to him, and his heirs forever -

7th Item, I give and bequeath unto my son William Hatley, Five Negroes, namely, Gary, Cliza, Lewis (son of Amy) Sidney, and Jane, to him and his heirs forever -

8th Item I give and bequeath unto my three sons, namely, Britton Hatley, Redden Hatley, and William Hatley, all my lands, with certain reserves, hereafter mentioned to them and their heirs forever -

9th Item, I give and bequeath unto my daughter Lulpha Hatley, in addition to what, I have heretofore given

- her, One Sorrel horse Call'd Starling, Two Cows, and Calves, Two Sows, and Pigs, to him and his heirs for ever -
- 10th Item, I give and bequeath, unto my son William Hally, in addition to what I have heretofore given him, One Sorrel horse Call'd Jolly, Two Cows, and Calves, One Sow and Pigs, also One bed, bedstead and furniture - to him and his heirs for ever -
- 11 Item, I give and bequeath unto my two daughters, Lelpha Hally and Cynthia, in addition to what I have heretofore given them, One Negro Girl by the Name of Mary, also all the Remaunders of my beds, bedsteads, and furniture that I have not heretofore given away, of all and every kind, also all the Table Cloths, Towels, Jewels, of all and every description, to be Equally divided between them, to them and their heirs for ever -
- 12 Item it is my Will and desire that my son William and my two daughters, Lelpha, and Cynthia, all Hally, should have the use, and privilege of my Dwelling house, with all other houses attached to the premises, that may be necessary for their use and Comfort, with a sufficient quantity of Open Ground for them, and their hands to tend, so long as they remain single, or unmarried and wishes to stay there on, then to be equally divided between my three named Sons, as aforesaid -
- 13 Item, it is further my Will and desire, that all the Residues of my Property, that I have not heretofore given away, be Equally divided, amongst my above named Children, viz Briton, Redden, Lelpha, Cynthia and John and William all Hally, - to them and their heirs forever
14. And lastly, I do hereby, nominate, Constitute and appoint, my two sons, Briton Hally and Redden Hally, Executors to this my last Will and Testament wishing all others well, by me made and acknowledged this and this only to be my last Will and Testament, in manner and form as above
