In the name of God amen
I Wriah Hally of the County of Chatham, and State
of North Carolina, being in my sixty fifth year of age
and in a low state of health, but sound in mind, and
memory, as usual, thank be to God for it, do make this my
last Will, and Testament in manner and form as follows

Item 1st I Will my soul to God that gave it to me
and my body to the Earth from Whence it Came
to be buried in manner and form as my Executors, or
Executrix, my hereafter direct

Item 2^d That all my just debts be paid

Item 3^d I give and bequeath to my loving Wife Aggy Hally
and Featherbed, bedstead, and furniture, that is generally
called mine by the family, also One Cow and Calf, and
Sow and Pigs, also three Geese and Lambs, and for his
years provision, I give him Four Hundred Pounds of
Pot. Ten barrels Corn, Three pounds Coffee, and Seventeen
Pounds Sugar ~~and~~ six head of geese -

Item 4th I leave to my loving Wife Aggy Hally, during her life
time, as Widdowhood, One third of the Tract of
land, that I now live on, including my dwelling
house.

Item 5th it is my Will and desire that all my negros, may be sold
with all and every part of my Perishable property
that I have not heretofore, willed away.

Item 6 I give and bequeath unto my six sons, namely William
Stanford, Wriah, Gelford, Jackson, ^{and} Lias, all Hally,
the tract of Land whereon I now live to be equal
ly divided, amongst them, by lot or Sale, Their choice
when, the youngest shall Come to age -

Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my three Daughters namely Rebecca Pilkington, Temperance Pilkington and Miley Hatty, all the residue of my Estate, that I have not heretofore will'd away -

Item 5th and lastly, I do hereby nominate, Appoint and Ordain my trusty friends William Hatty, and Thomas Bell, or either of them my Executor, or Executors to this my last Will and Testament, revoking all other Wills by me made, and acknowledge this, and this only to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form as above stated
